Price includes fees for supplies, all meals for Saturday breakfast, lunch and dinner, Cracker Barrel for Saturday night, Sunday breakfast and lunch.

**OWLS DETAILS:** Designed specifically for WEBELOS den leaders and their assistants, the Outdoor Leader Skills for WEBELOS course teaches outdoor-related skills through demonstration and hands-on practice. WEBELOS den leaders should attend this training before conducting an overnight camping trip with the boys and parents of the den. In addition to covering basic camping skills, this training features planning campouts and finding resources. This training is a requirement for the WEBELOS Den Leader Knot.



**OLSI DETAILS:** This course is designed for all Scoutmasters and Assistant Scoutmasters, Troop Committee Members and any interested adults who expect to play a supportive role in the success of a Boy Scout Troop. The course concentrates on introducing adult leaders to outdoor related Tenderfoot to First Class scouting skills. As well as the patrol method and various Boy Scout troop field procedures.

**WHAT TO BRING:** Overnight gear (tent, tarp, mattress/ground pad, lantern/flashlight, sleeping bag/blanket), outdoor essentials (comfortable chair, WEBELOS/Boy Scout Handbook, pen, paper/notepad, compass, water-proof matches, a 6-8 foot piece of natural rope, and rain gear), and appropriate scouting related camp clothes. **Carry a light load of what you need to keep yourself safe and to make a good camp. Leave all unnecessary items home! \*\* Bring only lightweight tents for two – NO CONDOS.** You will be carrying your equipment to your site. Arrive for this course in full Class A uniform. When you arrive, please meet at the Training Lodge (off the main parking lot) between 7:00 and 7:30 pm. You will be assigned a patrol and will proceed to set up camp (as a patrol) when directed by the course directors.

Come rested and be prepared to have a fun filled weekend!

**Cancellation Policy:** Once registration fees have been paid, an individual may become ill or otherwise be unable to attend an event. Since the event has already incurred expenses related to the activity such as program supplies, food, patches, etc., event fees are non-refundable & non-transferrable. An exception will be made if a request is received in writing or email (not phone) and submitted to the Southwest Florida Council Office by the individual no less than 24 hrs. before the date of the event. In some cases, only a partial refund can be made. Refunds for inclement weather will be made only if the event is cancelled.
