All youth & adult staff must be pre-approved by Mr. Marques and then register online.

There will be a \$5.00 late fee for registrations received after Thursday, January 7, 2021 at 11:59 p.m.

Payments are due to Council office no later than January, 14, 2021. Your unit is not considered registered until payment is received. ANY fees not paid by January 14, 2021 will incur late fees of \$5.00 per Scout/adult even if you registered early.

How to Register: **Registration will close on Thursday, January 7, 2020.**

Health Check In: All Staff and Participants must check in at admin for a mandatory health check.

Cancellation Policy: **Event Cancellation Policy:** Once registration fees have been paid, an individual may become ill or otherwise be unable to attend an event. As the event has already incurred expenses related to the activity such as program supplies, ins., food, patches, etc., event fees are non-refundable & non-transferable. An exception will be made ONLY if a request is received in writing or email (not phone) and submitted to the Southwest Florida Council Office by the individual no less than 72 hours before the date of the event. In most cases, only a partial refund can be made. **Refunds for inclement weather will be made only if the event is cancelled.** No refunds will be given on the Event Processing Convenience Fee.
