

If you're a new Cub Scout Leader, a parent of a Cub Scout who wants to get involved, or an experienced leader who is taking on a new position, then this course is for you!

Cub Scout Leader Position-Specific Training will show you what you need to know about Cub Scouting; the role and responsibilities of adult leaders (Cubmasters and their assistants, Den Leaders and their assistants, and Pack Committee Chairs and Members), and the resources available to help ensure your success.

This instructor-led offering is a comprehensive version of the basic training for Cub Scouters. After successfully completing this session, you will have completed the required leader-specific training for your required position. Cubmasters, Den Leaders, and their assistants also are required to complete Hazardous Weather Training (every two years), which is not part of this offering but is available on-line. Pack Trainers also need to complete The Fundamentals of Training, which is not part of this offering.

In-person training provides a wonderful opportunity for your entire leadership team to learn how all the positions work together to make a pack work, plus it fosters teamwork and allows for the sharing of ideas with other likeminded Scouters.

You will need to bring notepaper, pen or pencil, a sense of humor, and a willingness to learn. Please wear your Cub Scout Leader uniform (if you have one).
