What is Fundamentals of Training

This is the first part of the three-part train-the-trainer series (T3) in Scouting and is intended for both youth and adult trainers. This session is designed to introduce new Scouting trainers to teaching techniques and skills.

Most BSA's instructor-led training is designed around a variation of what educators are calling the "team-based learning model." Using small group promotes learning and team development through frequent and immediate feedback by a facilitator/instructor. It helps members learn from each other during and after the course. The team-based learning approach is similar to the patrol method Scouting has used for more than a century all over the world. The patrol method has proven effective in operating a den, patrol, squad, and crew, as well as in learning. We will use this method throughout the course.
