Unit Recognition: Identification of campsite inhabitants (American Flag, Unit flag, Patrol flags, etc.) is evident. American Flag is properly posted (on flagpole or hanging). (0-5)		
Safety: No safety hazards: low-hanging clotheslines, tools not properly stored, large rocks/limbs in walkways, etc. (0-5)		
• First Aid Kit easily accessible (0-5)		
• Fire extinguisher easily accessible (0-5)		
Health & Sanitation		
• Wash area: dish washing, clean water rinse, & bleach rinse (0-5)		
• Patrol boxes neat and orderly (0-5)		
• Trash disposal evident (0-5)		
Campsite Living Area		
• Evidence of Patrol organization: patrol flags, signs, etc. (0-5)		
• Tents neat & orderly (0-5)		
Tools neatly stored and organized (0-5)		
General Appearance/Public Area		
• Overall appearance of site is neat and clean (0-5)		
• Little to no trash on ground (0-5)		
EXTRA CREDIT ITEMS:		
• Gateway (natural materials, proper knots/lashings/rope ends, youth-constructed) (0-10)		
• Pioneering Gadget(s)		
• Useful and moderately complex: examples: no weather rocks, tripods, or other simplistic constructs (0-10)
