2023 Rifle & Shotgun Instructor Qualification Day

This event is only for those who have passed NRA Rifle & Shotgun Basic Course and are registered to take the NRA Rifle & Shotgun Instructor Course the weekend of February 24-26, 2023.

NRA Rifle Instructor Qualification

The Pre-Course Qualification must be administered before an Instructor Training Course and is a hands-on, practical exercise to evaluate an individual's knowledge, skills and attitude in safety, loading, unloading, clearing firearm malfunctions, and shooting skills. The NRA Pre-Course Qualification for Rifle will have a maximum score of 100 points and a minimum passing score of 80 points. Minimum passing requirement must be met in each phase.

NRA Shotgun Instructor Qualification

The Pre-Course Qualification must be administered before an Instructor Training Course and is a hands-on, practical exercise to evaluate an individual's knowledge, skills and attitude in safety, loading, unloading, clearing firearm malfunctions, and shooting skills. The NRA Pre-Course Qualification for Shotgun will have a maximum score of 100 points and a minimum passing score of 80 points. Minimum passing requirement must be met in each phase. The shooting phase will be administered as an official game of trap utilizing 5 stations.
