Cub Scouts - BALOO (Basic Adult Leader Outdoor Orientation)

This one and a half day course is designed as an introduction to the Cub Scout outdoor program for leaders interested in adding a camping component to their Pack activities. BALOO training consists of an online prerequisite component in addition to an overnight hands on practical. BSA's Cub Scout level camping policies will be taught along with the discovery of the necessary tools to help units carry out a successful camping experience. Completion of this course is mandatory for a MINIMUM OF ONE adult on a Pack overnighiter. Bring your camping gear, chair, mug and something to take notes with. Login to my.scouting.org with your account to take the online portion BEFORE arriving at camp.

Scouts BSA - IOLS (Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills)

This course will provide Scouts BSA leaders with the basic outdoor skills information needed to start and guide a program the right way. The skills taught are based on the outdoor skills found in The Scouts BSA Handbook.
