

Aquatics Training

BSA LIFEGUARD

May 2 – 4 & May 16 – 18, 2025 (Class begins Friday at 7:00 pm both weekends)

Successful candidates of this two weekends course will receive the following certifications: BSA Lifeguard, Snorkeling BSA, CPR/AED for Professional Rescuer, Standard First Aid. Candidates must be at least 15 years old. This course involves extensive swimming. You must be in good physical condition. **Candidates must attend both weekends to complete all certifications.** Certifications will be valid for two years upon completion of this training. Bring a cup/water bottle.

Cost: \$100 Registration fee includes all course materials, certification fees and meals (both weekends).

BSA Aquatics Supervisor (Swim & Water Rescue)

May 3, 2025 (8:00 am – 4:00 pm)

Expands on Safe Swim Defense course and is recommended to conduct safe aquatics activities. Candidates must be at least 15 years old. This certification will allow you to open council pool areas for unit use. Certification is valid for three years upon completion of this training. Cost includes certification, program materials and lunch. Bring a cup/water bottle.

Cost: \$25

BSA Aquatics Supervisor (Paddle Craft Safety – Basic Kayaking/Basic Canoeing)

May 4, 2025 (8:00 am – 3:00 pm)

Expands on Safety Afloat course and is recommended to supervise basic canoeing or basic kayaking on flat water. Candidates must be at least 15 years old. This certification will allow you to open council waterfront areas for use by units. (Valid CPR training also required). Certification is valid for three years upon completion of this training. Cost includes certification, program materials and lunch. Bring a cup/water bottle.

Cost: \$25

CPR for the Professional Rescuer Certification/Recertification

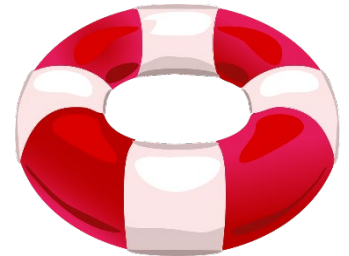
May 16, 2025 (7:00 pm – 10:00 pm)
