WHAT IS WOOD BADGE?

AS THE CORE LEADERSHIP SKILLS TRAINING COURSE FOR THE BSA, WOOD BADGE FOCUSES ON STRENGTHENING EVERY VOLUNTEER'S ABILITY TO WORK WITH GROUPS OF YOUTH AND ADULTS.

WOOD BADGE TEACHES PARTICIPANTS THE BASICS OF LISTENING, COMMUNICATING, VALUING PEOPLE, TEAM DEVELOPMENT, SITUATIONAL LEADERSHIP, PROBLEM SOLVING, AND MANAGING CON FLICT. ONCE THE SKILL IS LEARNED, EACH MEMBER IS GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO USE THE SKILL AS A MEMBER OF A SUCCESSFUL WORKING TEAM. AT THE CONCLUSON OF THE COURSE, EACH PARTICIPANT DEVELOPS A SET OF PERSONAL GOALS RELATED TO HIS OR HER SCOUTING ROLE KNOWN AS "THE TICKET." WORKING TOWARD THESE GOALS ALLOWS EACH PARTICIPANT TO PRACTICE AND DEMONSTR ATE NEW SKILLS.

AS A RESULT OF ATTENDING WOOD BADGE, PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ABLE TO RECOGNIZE THE CONT EMPORARY L EADERSHIP CONCEPTS UTILIZED IN CORPORATE AMERICA AND LEADING GOVERNMENT ORGANIZATIONS THAT ARE RELEVANT TO OUR VALUES-BASED MOVEMENT AND APPLY THE SKILLS THEY LEARN FROM THEIR PARTICIPATION AS A MEMBER OF A SUCCESSFUL WORKING TEAM.
