


Shooting Sports Trainings New Dates!

BB & Archery Range Master Course (Camp Flying Eagle) September 21, 2024 (9:00AM-2:00PM)

Certification required to permit BB and archery shooting at district/council sponsored events or on council property. Must be renewed every two years. Must be at least 18 years old.

Cost: \$10.00 Registration fee includes certification fee and all course materials. No meals are provided. Please bring a bag lunch.



Students learn NRA's rules for safe gun handling; rifle parts and operation, ammunition, shooting fundamentals, range rules, shooting positions, cleaning, and continued opportunities for skill development. These courses are pre-requisites for taking the NRA Instructor courses for Rifle & Shotgun. Instructor pre-requisite qualification will take place on January 18th, 2024 (an additional range fee will apply for qualification). Must be at least 16 years old. (Minimum 10 students required)

Cost: \$85.00 Registration fee includes meals, certification fees and all course materials.

- Age 16 18: You receive an Apprentice Certification
- Age 18 21: You receive and Assistant Certification
- Age 21: You receive your Instructor certification

Range Safety Officer Development Course (Camp Flying Eagle) November 9, 2024 (9:00AM- 4:00PM)

Become a Range Safety Officer. Learn the knowledge and skills you need to organize, conduct and supervise safe shooting activities and range operations. Must be at least 21 years old. (Minimum 10 students required) Cost: \$40.00 Registration fee includes certification fee and all course materials. No meals are provided. Please bring a bag lunch.

NRA Rifle/Shotgun Instructor Pre-Requisite Qualification (Camp Flying Eagle & Camp Miles) January 18, 2025 (8 AM – 4 PM)

The Pre-Course Qualification must be administered before an Instructor Training Course and is a hands-on, practical exercise to evaluate and individual's knowledge, skills and attitude in safety, loading and unloading, clearing firearm malfunctions and shooting skills.

The NRA pre-course Qualification for Rifle will have a maximum score of 100 points and a minimum passing score of 80 points.

The NRA pre-course qualification for Shotgun will have a maximum score of 100 points and a minimum passing score of 80 points.

Minimum passing requirement must be met in each phase.

The Shotgun shooting phase will be administered as an official game of trap utilizing 5 stations.

Minimum passing requirement must be met in each phase. Must be at least 18 years old.

Cost: \$40.00 No meals are provided. Please bring a bag lunch.
