FAQ:

• What is Sporting Clays?:

Clay Shooting is an event where you use a shotgun to shoot clay targets tossed in the air or across the ground. To add fun and competitiveness to the event, there are a number of shooting stations to test your skills. It is pretty similar to a charity golf tournament, but instead of completing 18 holes, participants experience 14 different shooting stations.

Do I have to walk the course?

• What is the money used for?

What are the rules of the range?

How long does it take?

Can I shoot by myself?

• Are drinks provided?

No, ammo is provided in 12 or 20 gage

No, a cart is part of the registration fee

Eye & ear protection are required as well as participating in the mandatory safety briefing

You can expect to spend three hours on the course depending on the number of clays thrown

No, you will be placed in a team of 4

Drinks will be provided, water/pop. Beer will be available after the shoot
