FAQ:

- What is Sporting Clays?:

Clay Shooting is an event where you use a shotgun to shoot clay targets tossed in the air or across the ground. To add fun and competitiveness to the event, there are a number of shooting stations to test your skills. It is pretty similar to a charity golf tournament, but instead of completing 18 holes, participants experience 14 different shooting stations.

- Do I need my own shotgun? Yes
- Do I need my own ammunition? No, ammo is provided in 12 or 20 gage
- Do I have to walk the course? No, a cart is part of the registration fee
- What is the money used for? Scouting programs in Southwest Florida
- What are the rules of the range? Eye & ear protection are required as well as participating in the mandatory safety briefing
- How long does it take? You can expect to spend three hours on the course depending on the number of clays thrown
- Can I shoot by myself? No, you will be placed in a team of 4
- Are drinks provided? Drinks will be provided, water/pop. Beer will be available after the shoot
