1. Log into [My.Scouting.org](#)
2. Click the red BSA Learn Center box on the right
3. Scroll to the heading "Expanded Learning"
4. Click the box marked "Program Safety"
5. Look for "Program Safety" again and click "+ Add Plan."
6. Click the "Program Safety" link, then click the "Drive Safely" link.
7. Begin the training

Once finished, a completion certificate will be provided and your official training record will be updated.
